What was the largest bill ever?

The largest bill ever printed by the Bureau of Engraving and Printing was the \$100,000 gold certificate. On it was Woodrow Wilson, the 28th president of the United States.

About 42,000 of the bills were printed between 1934 and 1935. They were only used for large transactions between Federal Reserve Banks.

Did you know that it costs money to make money? It costs about 11 cents to produce bills from \$5 to \$50. It costs money to make coins, too. Check out how much each coin costs to make!
